Barn Hunt is open to all breeds and mixed breeds of all sizes. Dogs must be 6 months of age or older to compete. Dogs must have a Barn Hunt number to enter. For a complete copy of the rules or to register a dog, go to www.barnhunt.com.

All participants and spectators must sign a COVID-19 waiver when they arrive.

At all times, the safety of the dogs, handlers, and rats, is to be of paramount importance. At will be humanely handled and safely confined in aerated PVC tubes. Barn Hunt is not intended to harm or kill rats.

## Notice to Exhibitors

* Invalid Entries - Entries are not valid for the following reasons: unsigned, no payment, incorrect payment, wrong information, incomplete information, to name a few. Complete list of reasons can be found in the Rules on www.barnhunt.com. Invalid entries will be notified and not processed until all information has been completed.
*. Payment will be processed when entry is received, i.e.: cashing of checks, run payment, etc.
> Non-Sufficient Funds - All payments returned with NSF will be subject to a $\$ 50$ fee.

## $>$ Day of Show Payments - Cash or checks only. <br> Et Entries/closing dates

> Entries - will be considered "on time" if postmarked by the entry closing date posted in the premium.
$>$ Day of Show (DOS) - Entries presented to the trial secretary on the day of a trial event during registration/check in.
$\rightarrow$ No entries will be accepted between the Late Entry close date and the day before the trial event.
$>$ Entries received before the open date will not be considered.
He Confirmations - Confirmations will go out in the form of email. Please print your email address clearly.
He Rules - It is the handler's responsibility to read and understand the rules in the Competitors Rule Book. Rule books can be found on the Barn Hunt Association website.
. Dogs may enter both Instinct and Novice in the same trial until the dog has earned the RATN title.
*. Bitches in season - BIS may compete at Barn Hunt Trials. They must wear pants and be kept separate from other dogs. BIS will run at the end of their class. Designated walking and crating area will be assigned or must crate out of vehicle. Please inform the trial secretary when you arrive for additional information.
He Height Divisions - Small (13" and under), Medium (13.1" to 18"), and Large (18.1" and over). Placements are based on height, please have an accurate height recorded.

* Dog Aggression - Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or person may be dismissed from the trial if justification found to do so by the judge and/or trial committee.
.4. Cancellation Policy - Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of an "Act of God" such as fire, flood, etc., an event may be canceled. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation. We will return all or part of the entry fees at our discretion.


## . Withdrawals/Refunds

$>$ Before closing date - If a competitor withdraws before the closing date, a refund will be issued, less any processing fees, within 5 days after the trial.
$>$ After closing date - Refunds may be given after the closing date, only if a wait list has been started and the runs are replaced by a dog on the wait list. If a refund is warranted, one will be issued, less any processing fees, within 5 days after the trial.
$>$ Withdrawal due to dog injury or illness - Refunds may only be given for dog illness or dog injury with a note from a Veterinarian. Notes must be presented before trial begins. A refund will be issued, less any processing fees, within 5 days after the trial.
Waitlist - When maximum run limit or maximum time limit is reached, a wait list will be started. If the runs are replaced by a dog on the wait list, a refund will be given. If a refund is warranted, one will be issued, less any processing fees, within 5 days after the trial.

* Move ups - will be allowed on appropriate days. This will be determined by the running order.

H Crating area - Please check in with the trial secretary for the designated crating area information. There is NO INDOOR crating at this trial. You may crate out of your car or outdoors.
\%. Dogs must be under control while on trial grounds. All dogs must be on a short leash or crated at all times unless actively working. RETRACTABLE LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON PREMISIS.
He Smoking/Vaping is not permitted within 50 feet of any straw, in the building or within 50 feet of the doorways.
*. Ribbons and Awards - Brown flat ribbons will be awarded for all regular class, qualifying runs. Instinct Title ribbons are brown flat ribbons and will be awarded for a dogs 1st qualifying Instinct run. Specific brown flat ribbons will be awarded to dogs with a positive score in Crazy 8s. Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st thru 4th place. High in Class rosettes will be dated and themed for each trial. For B Classes, the HIC will be in lieu of the 1st place rosette. New Titles awards will be given to dogs with 3 qualifiers in Novice A, Open A, and Senior A; dogs with 5 qualifiers in Master A; and dogs with 10 qualifiers in Novice B, Open B, Senior B, and Master B. New Title awards for regular classes will be rosettes, larger rosette ribbons will be awarded for a RATCH. New Title awards for Crazy 8 s will be neck medallions. Specialty awards may be offered at this event.
H. Ribbon Presentation - Results will be announced shortly after each class. Ribbons will then be placed on the ribbon display table to be picked up. Please allow the secretary sufficient time to input and calculate results. If you find yourself waiting around for your ribbons, help out in the ring while you wait. Results are tabulated at the end of the 2nd trial of each class.

* Trial Grounds - This trial will be held at Canine Adventures, located at 32250 W Eight Mile Rd, Farmington Hills, MI 48336. This is an indoor event. Heated warehouse but not climate controlled. Please dress accordingly. Please visit our website for overview map of grounds.
* Parking is free for this event.
. Food - Food will be available on site for purchase, all proceeds will benefit the animals of Louis' Legacy Pet Rescue. There are also food establishments nearby.
* Ring - Padded floor, combination of 4 ' black wire fence panels, $4^{\prime}$ lattice fence panels. Indoors.
* Blind - Indoors, minimum 10’ x 10' area, maximum 5 dogs in blind.
